Course Outline

2-day Intro to Overhead Doors

During this two-day course we will cover safe practice techniques to utilise when near and when operating 3 different types of overhead doors. You will learn to identify, and trouble shoot small issues before they turn into costly repairs. We will work to identify all the components of a sectional door, rolling steel (fire) and rubber door system. You will also learn to how to install a residential standard lift sectional door with side mount and trolley operators as well as install and drop test a rolling steel fire door. Upon completion of the course, you will be presented with a certificate indicating you have successfully completed the Intro to Overhead Door course and some cool NGD and supplier swag.

2-day Rolling Steel Fire Door course

During this two-day course we will cover safe practice techniques to utilise when near and when operating a rolling steel fire door system. You will learn to identify, and trouble shoot small issues before they turn into costly repairs. You will learn to identify all the components of a rolling steel fire door including the different materials and finishes. You will learn to install, service and operate as well as drop test and reset a rolling steel fire door system. You will learn about the various methods of operations and automatic closing devices. Upon the completion of the installation and drop test of the fire door system you will write an exam as proof of comprehension of the materials covered. Once you have successfully completed the exam, you will leave with a rolling steel fire door drop test and seminar competency certificate and some cool NGD and supplier swag.

2-week Technician Level 1 course

During this two-week course we will cover safe practice techniques to utilise when near and when operating a all types of door systems (sectional / rolling steel / rubber and man doors). You will learn to identify, troubleshoot and service small issues before they turn into costly repairs. You will learn to make door cables and measure springs for sectional doors. Identify all the components as well as install, service and operate a sectional door / rubber doors / rolling steel (fire) and man door. You will complete an in-class exam based 70 % hands on and 30% theory to prove comprehension and competency. Once you have passed the exam you will be awarded a level 1 NGD door technician's certificate.
